- ✓ Surge protector that has an on / off switch
- ✓ Alarm clock
- ✓ Microwave: 700 watt/.7 cubic feet
- ✓ Refrigerator: 4 cubic feet or less
- ✓ TV that is HD capable
- ✓ Video games, Coffeemaker, Computer
- ✓ 3M Command strips for hanging posters and pictures
- ✓ Laundry detergent, basket, hangers
- ✓ Linens for extra-long twin bed, towels
- ✓ Tension rod/curtain rod for Centennial Hall closet
- ✓ Carpet or rugs with a non-slip rug pad
- ✓ Lamp (no halogens)
- ✓ Personal hygiene items
- ✓ Flashlight and other tools

#### WHAT NOT TO BRING

- X Candles, incense, halogen lamps
- X Space heaters
- X Wireless routers
- X Extension cord that does not have a surge protector with an on/ off switch
- X Anything with an open heating element
- X Toasters, toaster ovens, hot plates, grills
- X Pets, except fish in a 10-gallon aquarium
- X Anything that may damage or mark surfaces such as tacks, nails, pins, screws, adhesives, or tape
- X Weapons of any kind
- X Drugs and or drug paraphernalia, including vape pens and tobacco products
- X Alcohol, including full or empty decorative bottles, caps or shot glasses



#### Where do we go to pick up our key?

Your key will be located in the main lobby of your residence hall. Signs will be posted throughout the residence halls with pertinent information and locations.

#### Do I need to do anything before I arrive?

Verify that your Admissions paperwork, student account obligations, and financial aid requirements are complete to avoid a hold your student account that will prevent you from getting moved in. Please complete your online portal check-in a few days before arriving to campus. Offices will be open to assist you in completing any requirements during move-in.

#### Will I get help moving in?

During Freshmen move-in, TLU will have numerous volunteers assisting you. Please label all of your items with your name, building, and room number to ensure they arrive to the correct place. Limited carts will be available on a first come first serve basis.

#### Which buildings have elevators?

Centennial & Seguin Halls are the only on-campus residence halls with an elevator.

#### Can I move in early?

We are unable to schedule early move-ins due to rooms being prepped. Severe situations will be addressed by the Campus Living office on a case by case basis.

#### What do I do if I'm scheduled to move-in with my team / organization?

Your coach / organization leader will supply Campus Living with a roster of all students who will move in with their group. Confirm with them for more details.

#### Will the dining hall be open by the time I arrive?

Dining services will be open at lunch on move-in day and you can begin using your meal plan immediately. Your TLU ID has your meal information pre-loaded onto the card.
