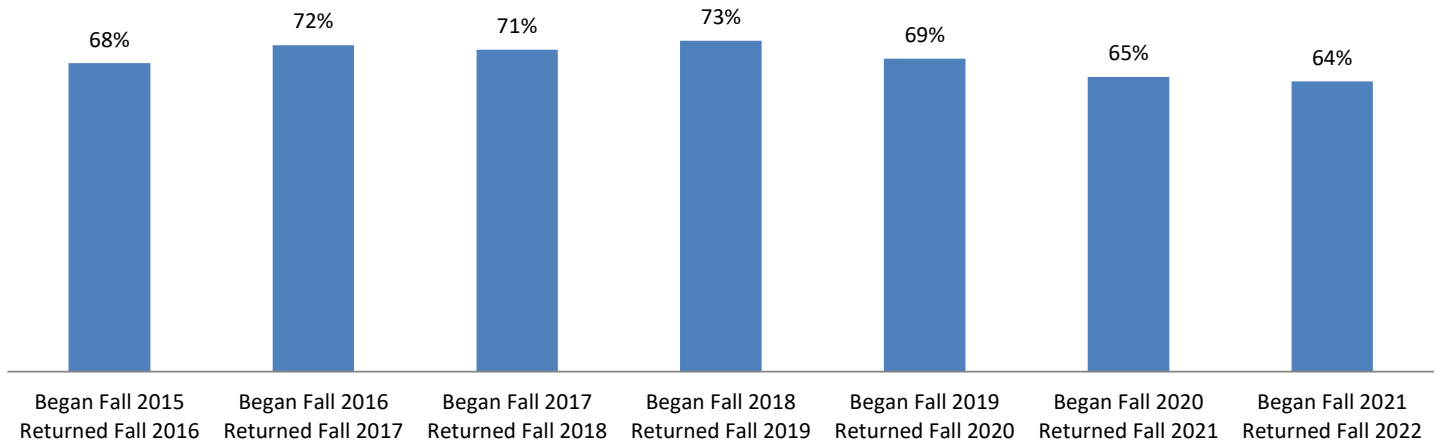

Retention Rates

Retention Rates measure the percentage of first-time, full-time students seeking a bachelor's degree who return to the institution to continue their studies the following fall.

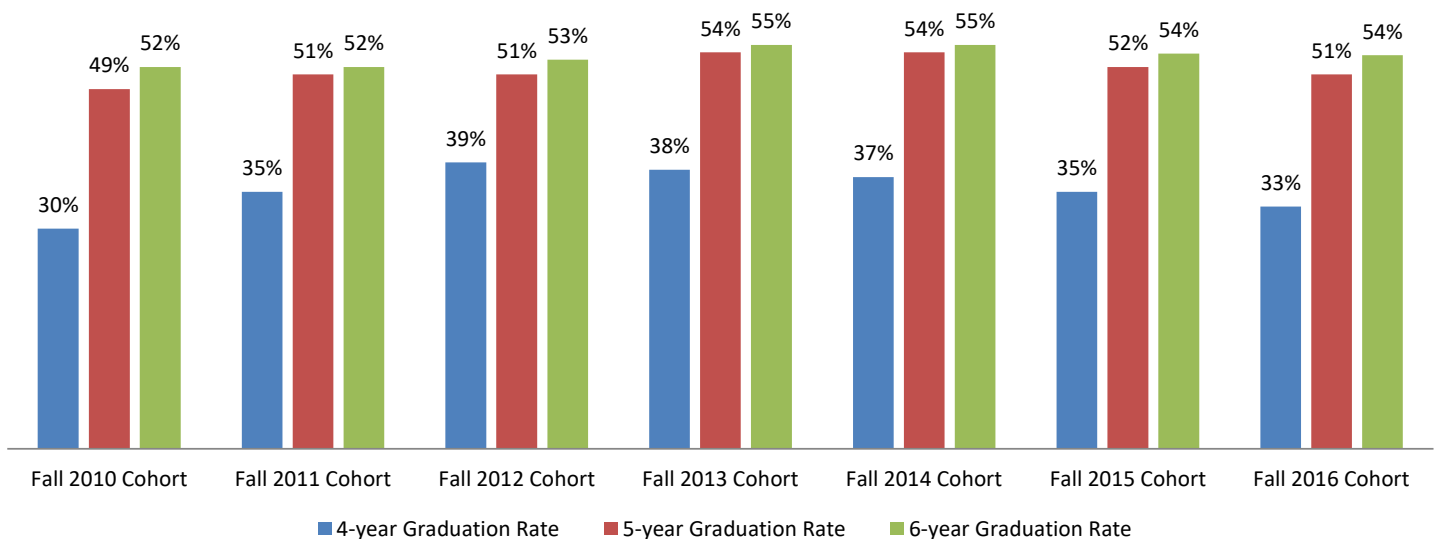
Fall-to-Fall Retention of First-Time, Full-time Degree Seeking Undergraduates



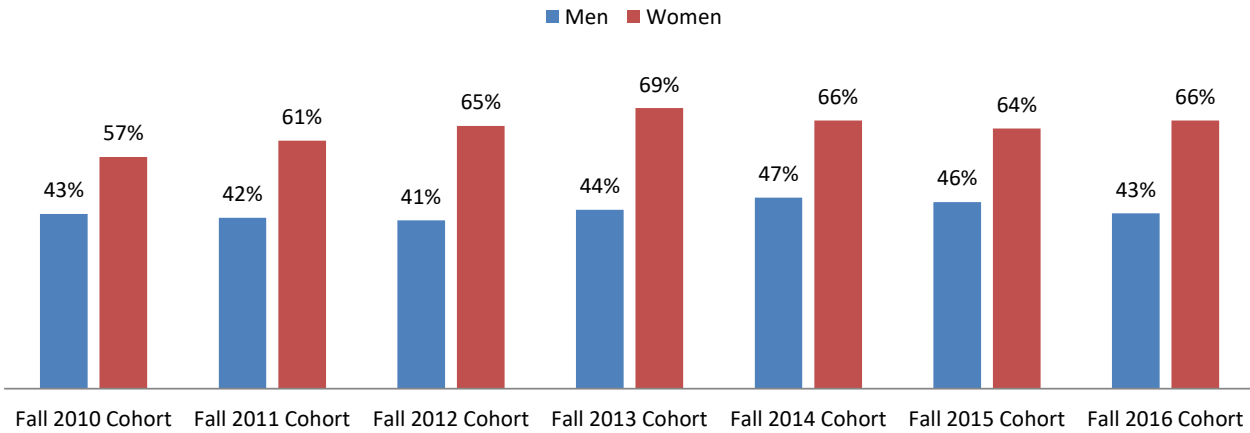
Bachelor's Degree Graduation Rates

Bachelor's degree graduation rates measure the percentage of entering students beginning their studies full-time and are planning to get a bachelor's degree and who complete their degree program within a specified amount of time.

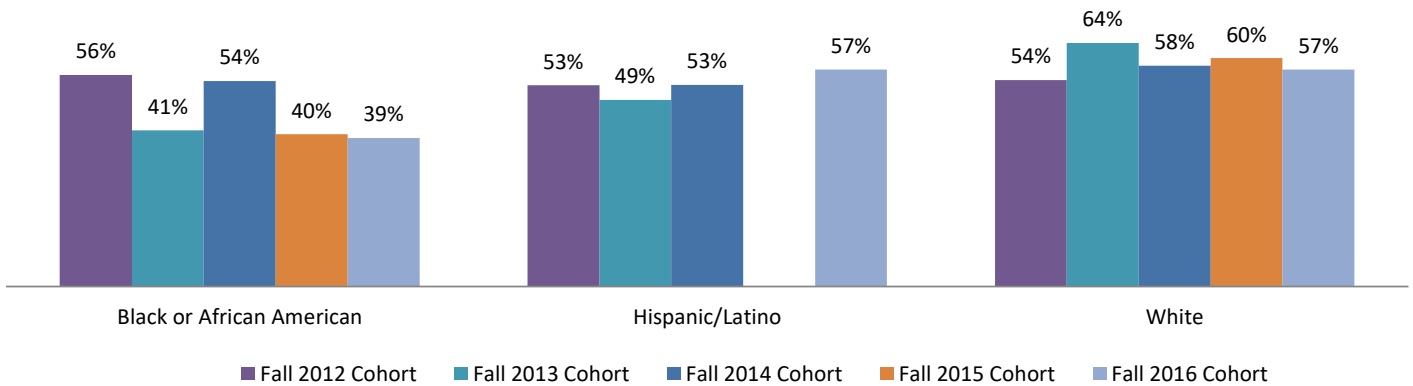
Four, Five, and Six Year Graduation Rates



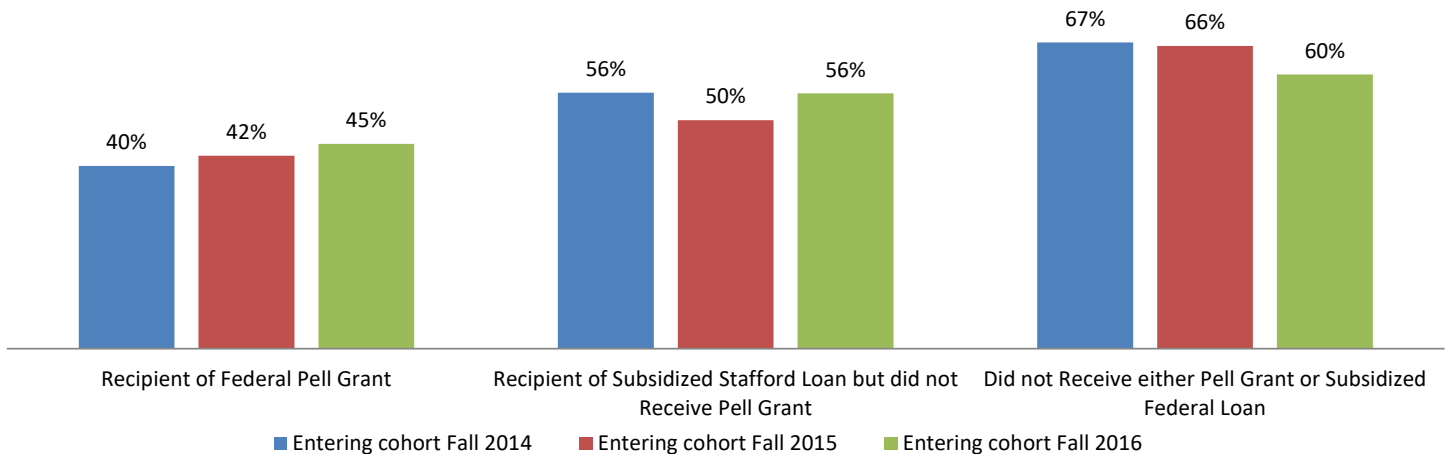
Six Year Graduation Rates by Gender
