DIII colleges and universities cannot offer any athletically related scholarships or financial aid. Financial aid procedures are the same for all students – athletes and non-athletes - which means all students may apply for academic scholarships, music and theatre performance scholarships, institutional, federal and state need-based grants, and federal direct loans.

TLU offers generous academic scholarships ranging from **\$20,000 to \$25,000** a year. Want to know how much you could earn in academic scholarships? Visit our Scholarship page at tlu.edu. We encourage you to file your FAFSA to determine eligibility for need-based grants and federal loans. You may also meet with our financial aid counselors to get an estimated cost of attendance.

CHARACTER

We look for students of character first and foremost. Students must be leaders on the field and in the classroom. They should be men and women of great character – people who put others first.



ACADEMICS

Student-athletes of character must also demonstrate they possess the academic ability to complete college-level work. This means they have self-discipline, time management skills, and most importantly, the determination and commitment to succeed in the classroom.



ATHLETICS

Student-athletes who demonstrate character and academic ability must also possess the athletic ability and talent to win in a game, match, or meet. They must also prove they are leaders and understand the value of being part of a team.
