HEERF III Quarterly Report September 30, 2021

TLU received funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to assist students who were affected financially due to disruption of university campus operations.

FUND REPORTING:

- On May 24, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education issued TLU a Grant Award Notification for
 the third round of Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF III) authorizing an additional
 \$1,969,104. TLU signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and
 Agreement that was issued with HEERF I (CARES Act) funds. TLU will use no less than 50 percent
 of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency
 Financial Aid Grants to its students. These additional funds were authorized under the American
 Rescue Plan Act.
- No awards have been made during the third quarter of 2021.
- As of September 30, 2021, TLU has distributed HEERF III emergency grants totaling \$322,500 to 258 students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act and American Rescue Plan.
- For the Fall 2021 semester, TLU estimates **1,417** students eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

The eligibility criteria and application process for the remainder of the HEERF III funds will be issued with our next quarterly report.
